
Cuddle® Cube soft blocks

sorap buster

Fabric & Notions/Supplies
Scraps of Cuddle® or Luxe Cuddle® fabric
Fusible interfacing
Hand-sewing needle
Neutral color polyester thread
90/14 stretch sewing machine needle
Polyester fiberfill

Assembly Instructions

- 1. To embroider or applique (optional), use pieces larger than final block size. Embroider or applique as desired.
- 2. Cut six squares of Cuddle® 3, Luxe Cuddle® and/or Cuddle® Dimple each the same size. (For our samples we used 6" x 6" and 4" x 4").
- 3. Cut six squares of fusible interfacing the same size as your Cuddle® squares.
- 4. Using a low-heat iron, fuse interfacing to Cuddle® squares.
- 5. Arrange squares in a T layout, making sure that nap is going in the same direction for all pieces.
- 6. Pin pieces right sides together, two at a time, and sew with a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat with remaining squares to create the T shape shown below.





7. Following the diagram, sew seams together to create the cube. On seam 5, leave a 2-3 inch opening, as shown.

- 8. Stuff with polyester fiberfill until as firm as desired.
- 9. Hand-sew opening closed.
